**I. PURPOSE**

College of Notre Dame of Maryland enter into this Articulation Agreement with the University of Maryland Baltimore programs (as outlined in the attached articulation agreement) to outline how their credits will transfer to the University of Maryland Baltimore for general education, major and graduate work leading to a baccalaureate degree at College of Notre Dame of Maryland.

Students need to have **completed program** (as outlined on the articulation agreement) at College of Notre Dame to be eligible for consideration for transfer of courses in the following categories:

**First three years:**

- Accounting
- Finance Management
- Social Work
- Social Work
- Accounting or Finance

**II. ASSIGNED RESPONSIBILITIES**

- A. Notre Dame will:
1. Accept the requirements for transfer of their first three years of credit with this agreement and the University's Transfer Policy.
  2. Accept transfer-able credit for a maximum of 90 credits.
  3. Continue working with the University on the articulation agreement.
  4. Award 25% tuition discount to the University if a co-transfer student from the University of Maryland Baltimore Women's College.
  5. Provide opportunity for a 30% tuition discount to the University if a co-transfer student from the University of Maryland Baltimore College if TOEFL score is advised.
